Reviewing Stands

The Krewe of Pygmalion's Official Reviewing Stand will be at the Hotel Intercontinental, 444 St. Charles Avenue.

Tickets are \$65.00 per person, includes dinner, coffee, tea and champagne at the toasting; guests must be 16 years or older.

Dress is Casual Dressy, absolutely NO JEANS of any sort.

Guest should arrive at the Marriott New Orleans Convention Hotel, 859 Convention Center Blvd NO later than 4:00pm to board the Limos for a toast at the staging area of the parade.

Limos will then bring you to the Hotel Intercontinental and upon conclusion of parade the Limos will bring you back to the Marriott New Orleans Convention Center.

Float Showing & Load Up

Float Load Up will take place on **Saturday, February 4, 2012** from **2pm - 5pm** at the Rizzuto & Company's den, 10016 River Road, St. Rose, LA. This is a time for you to come view the floats up front and load up your throws! If you ordered from the Krewe, distribution of your throws will take place during this time as well.

Food, Beer and Soft Drinks will be provided.

THROWS

We have a limited amount of throws left to purchase. We will have some of the throws for viewing at the General Membership Meeting as well as the Float Load Up.

PARADE DAY INFO:

It is important that you follow the instructions of your float Lieutenant. Your lieutenant is responsible to assure that all city and Krewe rules and regulations are followed. Your lieutenant has the authority to remove anyone from the float who does not follow these instructions.

It is not permitted to throw anything, which has the name of any Krewe other than the Krewe of Pygmalion.

Please know ahead of time when and where things are taking place. Krewe officers are very busy on the day of the parade and it's difficult to give you instructions at that time.

DO NOT REMOVE MASK OR ANY OTHER PART OF COSTUME

Participants must be decently attired

No participant shall be obviously intoxicated

No smoking on the floats

No glass is allowed on floats

No silly string, stink bombs, stink spray, bomb bags, or laser pointers on board

Do not litter the route or staging area with cartons or packaging

Do not ask tractor operator to make unscheduled stops

Do not distribute throws in the assembly area or disbanding area

Do not use nails on floats. Only screw hooks are permitted to hang your throws
